This is because the plasma portion of your blood we inject contains cells that are responsible for releasing growth factors and attracting the stem cells that then go on to create new skin cells and collagen.

PRP is a bioactive stimulator, not filler. It will increase collagen and thicken your skin to give you a firmer, younger looking skin we all desire.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is Platelet rich plasma?

PRP (Platelet rich plasma) is the latest technology in skin rejuvenation, using your own cells derived from your blood, that re

then re-injected into the skin to stimulate collagen and new skin cells.

Where does the 'platelet rich plasma' come from?

Your blood is rich in these components; red blood cells, white blood cells, and plasma. We only need to use the plasma portion of your blood, which is rich in white blood cells; so a special process has been developed to obtain this portion. You will only receive treatment with your own cells.

What can I expect?

A vibrant, fresh youthful skin and a reduction in fine lines and wrinkles; due to the new collagen formation.

Dr SueFong can give you details on how effective this treatment will be for you, and how many treatments you may require.

What does the treatment involve?

A small collection of blood is taken and processed to give use the PRP required for your treatment. This plasma is then injected into your skin in a relatively straightforward procedure, much like having other cosmetic injections.

Results take around 2-3 weeks to see and a series of treatments is recommended.

Is PRP safe?

PRP is 100% your own cells (autologous) and therefore there is no risk of allergy, rejection. PRP is inherently safe.

How long does PRP last?

After 2-3 initial treatments, a repeat treatment should be done within 2 years.

Other things you should know:

Not all grades of wrinkling or skin laxity can be improved and may require a combination of treatments. Dr SueFong will advise you on this.

Smoking and alcohol consumption shortens the life of the new cells.
